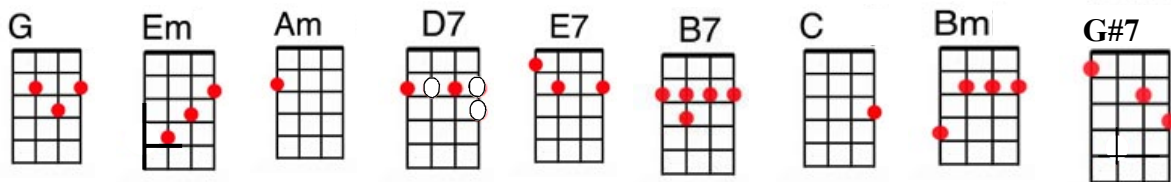




Have Yourself A Merry Little Christmas— Martin & Blane
