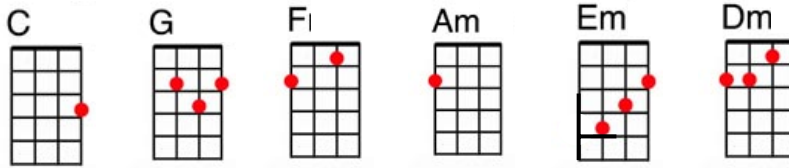




When A Child Is Born—Zacar & Jay
